

Advisory Board actions and key messages 23 April 2025

Chair and CEO update

Our Chair, Professor Reecha Sofat, thanked Lorraine Foley for her drive an ambition during her years as CEO after announcing she has stepped down

Lorraine said a few words about her time at PRSB. She emphasized the progress that has been made and reinforced that she hopes the good work continues. She thanks our Members and the PRSB team.

Reecha then introduced Oliver Lake as our new (transition) CEO. Oliver spoke about his appreciation for Lorraine's commitment to PRSB. He also touched on his optimism for the future, even in challenging times.

Work programme update

PRSB had made positive progress on the Common Data Model projects, the initial consultation is beginning with expert reference groups.

Common Data Model

Sarah Jackson from PRSB gave an update on the Common Data Model (CDM) project, covering:

- What CDM aims to achieve

- The two components covered at the moment, theatre scheduling/productivity and equipment and devices

Obstetric Anaesthesia minimum dataset (Obstetric Anaesthetic Association)

Development of minimum dataset to standardise obstetric anaesthesia records, enabling improved care and audit. We will be consulting with relevant professionals during the Spring.

NHS Health Check (Department of Health and Social Care - CISS)

Development of an information standard for Physical Health checks.

Diabetes Implementation (NHS England)

Support for technical implementation and piloting of diabetes standards plus an implementation toolkit and templates and preparation for upcoming commission on Continuous Glucose Monitoring profile

Common Data Model (NHS England)

Assessment of PRSB + other standards against proposed CDM and engagement with stakeholders on proposed model

Epilepsy standard (RCPCH)

Development of standard and implementation following RCPCH funded initial work (now published on our website).

Data (Use and Access) Bill - DCF discovery

Assessment of standards required by the DCF framework and report to NHS England

London Ambulance Service - review of Case Summary and compliance with standards

Review of Cleric ePCR's Case Summary which is sent to hospitals against compliance to most appropriate PRSB Standard (e.g. Ambulance handover to emergency care standard) to understand compliance and potential remediation required.

Person Characteristics Discovery (NHS England)

Consultation on proposed person characteristics and endorsement from professional bodies

HIQA - Ireland

Training and development for new HIQA standards team learning from PRSB's experience
